



ROLAND-GARROS 2019

NON-RIGHTS HOLDER ENG CREWS AND VIDEO JOURNALISTS RIGHTS

The following policy is aimed at all non-rights holder ENG crews and video journalists coming to Roland-Garros 2019 to explain the material they can or cannot shoot and broadcast during Roland-Garros 2019.

1. NON-RIGHTS HOLDER CREWS / VIDEO JOURNALISTS HAVE THE RIGHT TO FILM:

- **Training courts:** only Roland-Garros and Jean-Bouin practice areas and only during the qualifying week (20/05-25/05 inclusive)
- **General pictures in public areas** (alleys, crowd, animations...) inside the Roland-Garros stadium

2. NON-RIGHTS HOLDER CREWS / VIDEO JOURNALISTS DO NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO FILM

2.1 Courts

- Match actions on competition courts
- Training courts:
 - During the qualifying week: in practice centres other than Roland-Garros stadium and Jean-Bouin's practice centre
 - After the qualifying week

2.2 Other stadium areas

- Inside restricted areas such as players' areas
- Stand-up and TV shows within the Roland-Garros venue and/or Jean Bouin's practice centre (either live or delayed)

2.3 Media areas/events

- Press conferences: non-rights holders can attend press conference rooms without filming, the shooting being conducted by the FFT and footage being available at the rate card cost (please contact booking@fft.fr)
- The official draw ceremony: non-rights holders can attend the draw without filming, the shooting being conducted by the FFT and footage being available free of charge upon request about an hour after the end of the draw (please contact booking@fft.fr)
- Media Day:
 - non-rights holders can have access the press conference of the media day without filming, the shooting being conducted by the FFT and footage being available free of charge upon request (please contact booking@fft.fr)
 - non-rights holders are not authorised to access (or to film) media day television interviews (even in a pool): footage of television interviews conducted by FFT will be available free of charge upon request (please contact booking@fft.fr)

3. NON-RIGHTS HOLDER CREWS / VIDEO **DO NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO BROADCAST LIVE** ANY CONTENT FROM EITHER ROLAND-GARROS OR JEAN-BOUIN PRACTICE CENTER

4. INTERVIEW RIGHTS

All player interview requests must be submitted to the interview desk (located in the press centre).

One-to-one interviews are not allowed for non-rights holders.

Non-rights holders can only have access to pool interviews and/or mixed zone with the players of their nationality

This policy must be read and accepted before submission of accreditations for the tournament.

Please note that in the event of non-compliance with the any of the FFT regulations, we reserve the right to remove accreditations.
